TALK IT OVER | LESSON 6

Hey parents! Use these questions as a guide to talk over this week's lesson about the Bible story, **The Apostles and the High Council**, with your child after they've watched the video service!

1. What was your favorite part of the video we just watched?
2. In today's Bible story, why were the apostles arrested?
They told people about Jesus and that made some people angry.
3. Why were the apostles able to keep telling people about Jesus and God's love?
The apostles loved Jesus and they wanted everyone to love him, too, so God sent an angel to get them out of prison so they could keep telling people about Jesus. God gave them the strength they needed to keep doing what was right, even when other people told them to stop.
4. In Super Skuppets, how did they defeat the Bad Skuppet?
They worked together to destroy the Happy Zapper. They couldn't do it on their own strength. Like our Bible story, the apostles needed God's help. God gave them strength and hope. They were strong because they knew God's promises.
5. How can you remember God's promises?
You can remember God's promises by praying, reading your Bible, going to church, and talking with other people who believe in God. God will give us the strength we need because he loves us.
6. Pray with your child and thank God for his good promises! You might pray something like this: *Dear God, thank for loving us so much and for your promise to give us strength. Help us be strong to do what is right. Thank you for people in our lives that help us learn more about you and your promises. We love you so much. Amen.*
