GOD'S PROMISES MEMORY CARD GAME

Use this craft to remind your child of God's promises to us, including his promise to make us strong. With the memory cards they make, they will play a memory game to reinforce their understanding of God's promises to them.

DIRECTIONS

PREP

- 1. Print 2 copies of the God's Promises Memory Cards printable.
 - Option: Create your own design using the printable as a guide.

DO

- Let your child have fun coloring the memory cards. There should be 2 of each card.
- 2. Help your child cut out the memory cards.
- 3. Play a game with the cards and remember the promises you read are God's promises to you.
- 4. How to play:
 - a. Shuffle the God's Promises Memory Cards.
 - b. Lay them down in 4 rows, face down.
 - c. Turn over any two cards.
 - d. If the two cards match, keep them.
 - e. If they do not match, turn them back over and try again.
- 5. As you play, talk about each promise from God to us.


